# **Free Flight Airplane Instructions**

#### Installing the "AA" batteries in the charger.

- 1. Open the battery compartment cover by removing the cover
- 2. Install two new "AA" alkaline batteries paying close attention to the polarities +/- inside the compartment.
- 3. Replace the cover.

### Charging your Airplane for flight.

**NOTE:** Keep your hands and all other objects away from the propeller when charging and launching your Free Flight Airplane.

- 1. Make sure the power switch on the bottom of the airplane is in the "OFF" position.
- Insert the white charge jack into the charging port on the plane. The jack inserts properly only one way. It should insert very easily, without added force.
- 3. Allow the plane's battery to charge for 5 10 seconds. Then, remove the charger.

## Launch your Free Flight Airplane.

- 1. With your fingers away from the propeller, turn the power switch to the "ON" position and launch your free flight airplane.
- 2. Hold your plane by the fuselage with its spinning propeller pointing away from you.
- 3. Gently toss it into the air at a slight upward angle and watch it fly!

## **Battery Safety Information**

- Batteries should always be replaced by an adult.
- Do not mix old and new batteries.
- Do not mix different types of batteries such as alkaline, standard (carbon-zinc), or rechargeable (nickel-cadmium) batteries.
- Use only the recommended battery type. ie. "AA" Alkaline.
- Install batteries paying close attention to the polarities +/- inside the compartment.
- Exhausted batteries should be removed from the toy.
- Do not short-circuit the supply terminals.
- Save these warnings for future reference.

Caution: Do not expose batteries to fire as they may leak or explode.
